2. Participants to be MSGNA members for at least one year prior to the display date. Current officers and Board members cannot participate.
3. A research, education or clinical theme and be submitted on a 2 ft by 4 ft background.

Three MSGNA members will be chosen at random to judge the posters. All Board members are excluded from judging. In the event of a tie, the President Elect, will select an impartial person to act as a tiebreaker.

Posters will be judged based on:

The winner will be expected to do the following:

1. Send their abstract to SGNA by the date due.
2. Transport, set up, and breakdown the poster at the SGNA Annual Course.
3. Enlarge the poster to a 4 x 8 ft. display.
4. Attend the SGNA Annual Course. In the event the winner is unable to attend, the monies must be returned to the MSGNA via the current treasurer within 30 days of the SGNA Annual Course.

Monetary awards will be based on the availability of funds to be used towards expenses to the SGNA Annual Course. (The winner must present the treasurer with a letter of acceptance or denial from the SGNA to receive money to attend the Annual Course.)

House of Delegates Resolutions:

1. Whereas, GI professional nurses provide skill based volunteer work on mission projects, resolved that SGNA provides 2 medical mission scholarships annually in the amount of \$1000 each.
