What is C.O.M.O.N?

I’m Debbie Schroeder and in addition to being Director–at-Large of Policy and Procedures I am your representative to THE Coalition of Michigan Organizations of Nursing (C.O.M.O.N). This organization is “dedicated to the advancement of Nursing in the State of Michigan. C.O.M.O.N’s mission is to serve as a vehicle that gives all nurses the opportunity to collectively work together to achieve mutually agreed upon goals for Nursing in Michigan”. Membership in C.O.M.O.N includes over 40 different nursing specialty organizations. Some examples are: MSGNA, Academy of Med/Surg Nurses, American assoc. of Critical Care Nurses, Michigan College of Nursing., Michigan Assoc. of CRNA’S. Michigan Board of Advanced Practice Nurses just to give you an idea.

Annually C.O.M.O.N selects an initiative. The last one was in 2012 and it supported the Primary Care Consortium Adult Immunization Initiative. “As more emphasis is placed on the benefits of preventative services at both State and National levels, COMON urges all Michigan nurses to support the Michigan Primary Care Consortium Initiative of improving immunization and primary care access for all Michigan residents”

5. Establish the Michigan Nursing Practice Council

ABCGN Certification/Recertification Scholarships

This helps the evaluation of your application by providing complete information to the audit team. Having the agenda helps to determine if a course was "GI Specific" or not.*
